

Drovers' Tryst Photo Competition 2011

Who can enter?

Anyone who takes part in any of the Drovers' Tryst activities during the Festival.

What is the idea?

The idea is to record either a **Scenic** picture that could include wildlife and flowers or a **People** picture that shows them taking part in any of the Tryst activities. It must however be taken during a Tryst event.

How do I enter?

Entry is by email to Keith Ratcliffe at dtphotocomp@btinternet.com putting PhotoComp in the subject line. In the email please include your Name, give each of your pictures a Title and indicate whether it is in the Scenic or People category. You can submit up to 6 pictures in total.

Are there any Technical things I need to know?

The pictures can be either as taken or edited by you later and must be saved as either JPEG or TIFF format. Because they are going on to the Flickr website they will be reduced in size so that the longest side is 1024 pixels – if you know how to reduce your picture to this size please do so but if you don't then send it to Keith who will sort it out for you. If you take pictures with film then get in touch with Keith via the link under Help below.

Can I see my pictures on the Internet?

All pictures submitted will go onto the Drovers' Tryst page on Flickr and will be accessible via a link from the Main website. You do not need an account to submit or view them.

What can I win?

There is a prize of a £20 Amazon voucher each for the Best Scenic & the Best People picture. Both of these will be printed, framed and displayed at the Crieff Visitor Centre during the next Drovers' Tryst. A selection from all of the pictures submitted will also be displayed alongside the winners.

When must I submit?

The closing date for entries is Friday November 11th 2011. Results will be announced a short time afterwards.
