<b>EXTRA HARD WALKS</b>	<b>Ben Vorlich, Stuc A'Chroin and Beinn Each</b> This walk will take in two Munros and a Corbett. <b>14km, 8hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 1300m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>	<b>The Rannoch Wall - Beinn a'Chreachain and Beinn Achaladair</b> An energetic day climbing two Munros that rise majestically above the ancient Rannoch Moor glacial basin. <b>20 km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 1301m</b> <b>£10, Carshare</b>	<b>Beinn Ghlas-Ben Lawers-An Stuc</b> A high level linear walk, taking in three Munros. <b>14.5km, 7/8hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 1364m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>	<b>Creise and Meall a'Bhuiridh</b> A demanding walk over a popular Munro to reach a second, less frequented Munro. <b>10.5km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 1100m</b> <b>£10, Carshare</b>
<b>HARD WALKS</b>	<b>Ochils Inn to Inn: Sheriffmuir to Tormaukin</b> Starting at a 17 <sup>th</sup> century drovers' inn, this walk leads east to Blairdenon hill and along the top of the Ochils escarpment. <b>20.5km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 766m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>	<b>Benvane, Balquidder to Brig o'Turk</b> From Glen Buckie to Glen Finglas taking in Ben Vane. <b>14.5km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 747m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>	<b>Schiehallion - Hill of the Caledonians</b> Climb an Iconic Munro, enjoy some of the best views in Scotland from the top, weather permitting. <b>10km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 750m</b> <b>£10, Carshare</b>	<b>Coffin Route - Inverarnan to Inverlochlarig</b> This walk follows a route used to take coffins from Glen Falloch to the old church at Balquidder, where Rob Roy is buried. <b>16km, 6.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 780m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>  <b>Loch Freuchie to Loch Tay</b> Follow part of the Rob Roy Way from Glen Quaich to Ardtalnaig. <b>22km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 658m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>
<b>MEDIUM WALKS</b>	<b>Comrie Croft Circular</b> Lovely walk with great views over Strathearn valley, and visiting the tea plantation at Comrie Croft. <b>11km, 4hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 300m</b> <b>£10, Carshare</b>	<b>A Short Walk Through History: Ancient Romans and Ancient Books</b> Walk along part of the Gask Ridge. <b>10km, 4hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 50m</b> <b>£20 (includes Innerpeffray Library visit), Minibus</b>	<b>Glen Artney Nature Walk</b> A moderate walk following an established path through Glen Artney. <b>9km, 4.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 130m</b> <b>£16, Minibus</b>  Kindly sponsored by <b>Coopers Cottages</b>	
<b>EASY WALKS</b>	<b>Walk with a Beekeeper</b> Walk with a beekeeper and visit an apiary. <b>12km, 4.5hrs (+2hrs for bees)</b> <b>Ascent- 140m</b> <b>£10 , No transport required</b>	<b>DES</b>	<b>Crieff History Trail</b> An easy walk around the historic town of Crieff, with opportunities for learning along the way. <b>7km, 5hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 210m</b> <b>£10, No transport required</b>	<b>Walking with the Wild Plants</b> Join Strathearn Herbalist, Claire Mullan, for a walk along the hedgerows around Muthill. <b>7.4km, 5hrs</b> <b>Ascent- minimal</b> <b>£10, Carshare</b>  Kindly sponsored by <b>McNees Delicatessen</b>

<b>EXTRA HARD WALKS</b>	<p><b>Carn a'Chlamain - hill of the kite</b></p> <p>A remote Munro to the southwest of the Cairngorms - off the beaten track.</p> <p><b>26km, 8hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 930m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p>	<p><b>Arrochar Alps Ben Vane</b></p> <p>Climb the ESE spur of Ben Vane and enjoy good views of Loch Sloy dam, Ben Lomond and the Arrochar Alps - weather permitting!</p> <p><b>12km, 6hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 900m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p> <p><b>Meall Corranaich and Meall a'Choire Leith</b></p> <p>Climb Coire Odhar to the bealach between Beinn Ghlas and Meall Corranaich, before taking in these two summits.</p> <p><b>13km, 6.5hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 775m</b>  <b>£16, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Beinn a'Chleib and Ben Lui</b></p> <p>A challenging walk, involving a bit of wading as well as walking!</p> <p><b>10km, 7hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 1122m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p> <p><b>Beinn Mhanach - the monk's hill</b></p> <p>One of the remoter peaks in the southern highlands.</p> <p><b>21km, 7hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 819m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p>	<p><b>Meall nan Tarmachan</b></p> <p>A challenging and rewarding circular walk that gives wonderful views across Perthshire.</p> <p><b>13.5km, 7hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 875m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p>
<b>HARD WALKS</b>				<p><b>Kirkmichael to Ballinluig Drove Road</b></p> <p>Follow a droving route, taking in lochans Oisinneach Beag and Mor, from the Kirkmichael Tryst to the Crieff Tryst.</p> <p><b>16.22km, 6hrs</b>  <b>Ascent - 450m</b>  <b>£16, Minibus</b></p>
<b>MEDIUM WALKS</b>	<p><b>Exploring Coille Coire Chuilc</b></p> <p>Join Gareth Kett, one of the Loch Lomond Rangers, on a fascinating journey through Scotland's most southerly Caledonian forest fragment.</p> <p><b>9km, 6hrs</b>  <b>Ascent- 100m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p> <p><b>Lochearnhead to Killin via Glen Ogle</b></p> <p>Walk following disused railway lines, military roads and through tranquil forests.</p> <p><b>13km, 6hrs</b>  <b>Ascent- 200m</b>  <b>£16, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Wade's Road - Newton Bridge to Glen Cochil</b></p> <p>Newton Bridge to Glen Cochil with Wade expert, Colin Liddell</p> <p><b>13.5km, 5hrs</b>  <b>Ascent- 100m</b>  <b>£16, Minibus</b></p> <p><b>Acharn Hill and Falls</b></p> <p>Walk on the moors above Acharn.</p> <p><b>13km, 5hrs</b>  <b>Ascent- 450m</b>  <b>£10, Carshare</b></p>	<p><b>Along the Ochils - Alva to Glen Devon</b></p> <p>Follow in the footsteps of the drovers on this Woodland Trust Scotland walk.</p> <p><b>12km, 6hrs</b>  <b>Ascent- 376m</b>  <b>£16, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Crieff to Comrie via Torlum Hill</b></p> <p>An interesting off road walk over Knock Mary and around Torlum Hill.</p> <p><b>14.4km, 5hrs</b>  <b>Ascent- 240m</b>  <b>£16, Minibus</b></p>
