<b>EXTRA HARD WALKS</b>	<p><b>Ben Starav and Glas Bheinn Mhor</b> Excellent walking in an outstanding location. <b>16km, 9hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 1423m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p> <p><b>An Sochach</b>  <b>15km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 999m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p>	<p><b>Glenshee - 4 Munros</b> 4 Munros, demanding a certain level of endurance. <b>18.5km, 9hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 900m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p> <p><b>Sgiath Chuil, from Glen Lochay</b> A challenging day's walk of 16km to a lesser known Munro, with rewarding views of mountains directly to the north and south. <b>15km, 6.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 780m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p>		<p><b>The Two Munros of Buachaille Etive Beag</b> Stob Coire Raineach 925m and Stob Dubh 958m <b>12km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 958m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p> <p><b>Ben Lui Traverse</b> A traverse of the 4 Munros of the Ben Lui group (Beinn Dubhcraig, Ben Oss, Ben Lui and Beinn a Chleibh). <b>19km, 8hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 1700m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b></p>
<b>HARD WALKS</b>	<p><b>Glen Artney to Loch Earn</b> A beautiful linear walk with fantastic views through Glen Artney over to Loch Earn. <b>12km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 390m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Locheearnhead - Four Glens</b> The walk is into the hills to the west of Locheearnhead. It starts with a long steady climb up Glen Kendrum and then down Glen Dubh into Glen Dochart. <b>24km, 6.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent - 600m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p> <p><b>Ben Odhar</b> <b>13.5km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 840km</b> <b>£12 , Own Transport</b></p>	<p><b>Coffin Route - Inverarnan to Inverlochlarig</b> The historic 'Coffin Route' from Inverarnan to Inverlochlarig follows a route used to take coffins from Glen Falloch to the old church at Balquidder for burial and where Rob Roy is buried. <b>16km, 6.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 780m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b></p> <p><b>Historic Peat Road - Tempar to Fortingall</b> The walk starts near Kinloch Rannoch and climbs past the western foot of the famous and distinctive Munro, Schiehallion. <b>14km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 600m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Rannoch Station to Kingshouse, Glencoe</b> <b>19km, 6.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 300km</b> <b>£18 , Minibus</b></p>
<b>MEDIUM WALKS</b>	<p><b>Corrour to Rannoch</b> A 'must do' walk through the remote, untamed wild of Rannoch Moor. <b>18km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 245m</b> <b>£18 , Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>St Fillans to Killin</b> A linear walk from St Fillans to Killin. <b>21km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 500m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Killin to Locheearnhead via Glen Ogle</b> A linear walk through the spectacular Glen Ogle. <b>15km, 5.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 180m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b></p>	<p><b>Tall Trees and Tall Tales Around Dunkeld and Birnam</b> <b>14km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 150m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b></p>

		<b>Clover Leaf Walk</b> Do as much or as little of this 3 part walk which always comes back to the Glenturret Distillery. If you do all 3 leaves though you will be rewarded with a free tour and tasting courtesy of Glenturret! <b>21km, 7hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 280m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b>		<b>An Archaeological Trail to Glen Quaich</b> Take a trek through time and rediscover a lost landscape with local archaeologist Gavin Lindsay. <b>9.5km, 5hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 195m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b>
<b>EASY WALKS</b>	<b>The Tree Trails and Pinetum of Scone Palace</b> The grounds and pinetum of Scone Palace hold one of the finest collections of specimen trees in Scotland - tall tales of the tall trees by tree expert, Syd House. <b>9km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 100m</b> <b>£20 (includes entry), Own Transport</b>	<b>St Fillans to Comrie Nature Ramble</b> A slow and steady walk from St Fillans to Comrie, looking out for wildlife along the way. <b>9km, 5.5hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 100m</b> <b>£18, Minibus</b>	<b>Crieff History Walk</b> A gentle to moderate hike along the banks of the River Earn, up Tom n'a Chasteil, past the Baird Monument, and down Laggan Hill back into Crieff. <b>10km, 3hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 100m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b>	<b>Tyndrum Pinewood Wildlife Walk</b> A King's lost sword, a clan battlefield and ancient forest await us on this fascinating journey that starts at Dalrigh, the King's field near Tyndrum -itself at the convergence of old drovers' routes. <b>9km, 6hrs</b> <b>Ascent- 100m</b> <b>£12, Own Transport</b>
